Chief's Report and Possible Action:

- Informational items and reports- Chief Jones shared he received notice from Fire Recovery they may inactivate KLFPD status due to a lack of incidents reported since August 2025. Chief shared there haven't been reportable incidents recently. Fire Recovery there may be an opportunity to change contract to \$250/annually. 700 Form needs to be completed and returned to the County by April 1, 2026.
- Building Permit Status: Potential buyer for the vacant lots on Reed Street. Chief stated he a meeting was scheduled with the County, but it was cancelled.
- Update on Auto Dismantlers and Parts Storage Facility: No Update
- Fire Station Remodel Update and Possible Action: Some of the specialized work was sub-contracted out. GVD recently obtained permit. The project should start next week. Chief Jones also discussed painting the meeting room to match the project area.
- Equipment Report: Primer pump was replaced in 209, but apparatus may need to be return to the shop to have the primer valve replaced.
